Introduction

Have you ever found yourself wishing you could just crawl out from under the turmoil continually plaguing your life? That's certainly where I was for years and years. Many of the difficulties I dealt with as a child carried over into adulthood—things like insecurities, fears, guilt, doubt, condemnation, and shame.

Probably the number one insecurity in my life was the fear that I was never enough. I felt I was not as smart or as talented as others. I believed that others had better ideas, were more popular, were more this or more that. I felt I was never enough. Who was I really? Did I have a purpose in this life? Was I created for anything? Why was I here?

To say I was eaten up with all these underlying doubts and fears is an understatement. Then, one Sunday morning, at the age of twenty-nine in a suburb of Chicago, I gave my life to Christ. Jesus came into my life, and I was born again. Life instantly took on new meaning and purpose. I knew I had eternal life. I had passed out of the darkness and into His marvelous light (1 Peter 2:9)!

However, in the process of growing as a new Christian, I guess I "missed the memo" and thought it was all up to me to live this Christian life on my own because that's exactly what I attempted to do—live for God in my own strength. I did all the good works in an attempt to live for God, yet I still felt condemned, insecure, and riddled with guilt. I pictured in my mind that God was running away from me whenever I did something wrong. I believed that He was surely turning His back on me and would refuse to hear me or answer me when I prayed. In my mind, He was like a swivel chair. If I did good, I was back in His good graces. If I did bad, He would turn His back towards me again. Was all this really what I signed up for?

In addition to the hard path of trying to please God, my relationships were also hard for me, and I went through some tough times. I was either "too religious" and turned people off, or I would pull away, withdrawing from people completely. It seemed easier to simply pull away than to risk getting hurt.

Through some tough times and crushing crises in my life, God used a few amazing people to help me understand who I really am in Christ. One day a light bulb came on for me, an "aha moment" that was pivotal for me in my Christian life and has been so to this day.

I finally realized I was never meant to live this Christian life on my own. I now know *Christ is my life*, and *He lives His life* through me.

Why did it take me so long to figure this out? At last, I know I am in union with Christ, and contrary to what I used to think and believe, I will never, ever again be out of fellowship with Him. Christ is in me, and I am in Him (John 14:20).

I was given a brand-new heart at the moment I accepted Jesus. The old has gone, and the new has come (2 Corinthians 5:17). As a believer, my "wanter" has changed. From the moment I first accepted Christ, I have truly wanted to please God. That's my new nature, my new heart. Do I always succeed in doing what pleases Him? No, but my desire is for Him, and that has made all the difference.

Twenty years ago, I began to realize God had placed in me a gift to write poetry. It became an outlet and got me through some tough times. My first book, Come and Sit with Me Awhile, is a compilation of poems the Lord gave me during those years. God was using the very poetry He was giving me to heal my heart as I learned to pull away into the secret place with Him.

The book you are holding in your hands today, All My Desire, is a collection of poetry God downloaded into my heart throughout 2019 and 2020. I am sharing with you my personal journal through poetry. Since it is always coming forth through the relationship Jesus and I have together, you will find sometimes the words are in first person, and other times they are in third person. Some poems are just encouragement, and others are cries of the heart. You will note that a Scripture or two is added after each poem. I encourage you to reflect further on its meaning. Scripture says it will not return void (Isaiah 55:11), and my desire is that you will bear fruit and that God will speak to you personally.

It is my prayer you will experience healing and comfort and encouragement through this poetry, just as I have. He has healed me in so many ways. Now my greatest desire is to crawl up in His lap and let Him love me. My life now flows out of Christ, and my identity is in Him. I am in union with Him—Christ in me and me in Him.

You live in me and we are one; You're no longer far away. Cuz I've learned to trust You, You're my Life; your love is here to stay.


